A count of silver salmon present in this stream was made throughout the entire 1-3/4 to 2-mile area available to anadromous fishes. Estimate flow was 6-8 cfs with water clear and excellent for observations.

Results were as follows:

This represents a fairly accurate count of fish present since waters were clear and I had the help of three other people. I would estimate that we did not miss more than 10 fish at the most.

The fish were well distributed throughout the stream, with the exception of the North Fork, the 1/4 mile above the forks where fewer fish were seen. A total of 8 fish were counted above the forks.

On most riffles, 1-3 fish were seen. However, at several of the better spawning riffles, 6-7 fish were seen in the same area.
