REPORT OF TROUT MORTALITY OLEMA CREEK MARIN COUNTY

On August 26, Mr. J. F. Hedgepeth told me that a rancher on subject stream, which is tributary to Paper Mill Creek, had reported to him that a month or so previously all or nearly all of the trout in the stream had been killed. Cause of death was not known, although dairy pollution was suspected. Mr. Hedgepeth himself saw some live sculpins in the stream, but no trout.

Note of this report was made to Mr. Taft verbally on August 21 and is now put in letter form for purposes of record.
