Stream Survey Supplement

REDWOOD CREEK
Mendocino County

EXTENT OF OBSERVATION - This stream was surveyed from its mouth to a point approximately 1/2 mile above the Daniels and Ross Lumber Camp, total $3\frac{1}{2}$ mi. of stream by G. Holman, Stan Nye and Jim Morehouse on Jan. 20, 1959.

<u>Barriers</u> - Many log jam barriers exist throughout this 3½ mile section of stream. For further detail see the log jam survey data.

GENERAL ESTIMATE - The lower 3 miles of stream from its mouth to the Daniels and Ross lumber mill was logged off many years ago and since it has become very stable. In this section many log jams, some barriers, exist. Above the sawmill a more recent logging situation has taken place. In this upper section the stream has undergone considerable damage through logging operations. The stream has a potential of becoming a very good salmon stream if the log jams are removed.
