June 4, 1976

Observations by S. Ashuckian and C. Pinkham, Fish and Game  
Seasonal Aids.

A fish barrier composed of many large boulders blocking a narrow area of stream near the entrance of Sugarloaf State Park was observed. This barrier created a natural waterfall approximately 25 feet in height. A trail leading to the fall was located approximately 800 yards from the entrance gate of the Park. A walk of approximately 500 yards down the trail leads directly to the waterfall.
