

SODA CREEK, Trib. to Dry Creek
Mendocino County Field Note

Sept. 8, 1958: The following data was obtained during the rough fish control program on Sept. 8, 1958. A 50-ft. high shear rock, stepped falls is located 1.3 miles above the mouth of this tributary. This falls constitutes an absolute barrier to steelhead. The stream was surveyed above the barrier for 1.5 miles and no fishlife of any kind was noted. Aquatic insects were abundant. RT/SH ranging from 5-12 inches were quite abundant in this section of stream between the falls and the mouth. Air temperature on this date was 78 deg. F. water 79.5 deg. F. at 3:15 p.m. 1/2 mile above the mouth. The flow was estimated at 1/2 c.f.s. Flows were continuous throughout the stream on this date. RFE:cd
