Field Note March 10, 1966

Corral Creek, Tributary to WB Russian River, Mendocino County, from mouth upstream to the headwaters.

Observations :

Flows - estimated 4 to 5 cfs-clear

<u>Summer conditions</u> - Goes dry in the summer.

Fish present - None observed or seized. Local residents say that it is the exception to find spawning fish present in this stream.

Shelter - Poor throughout.

Recommendations

- 1. Complete stream survey at time when conditions are best for finding fish present.
- 2. Evaluate summer stream condition. Find out when stream goes dry and its affects on fishlife.
