SUBJECT: Fisher Creek, tributary to West Branch Russian River, Mendocino County, from mouth u/s to headwaters

OBSERVATIONS

Flow - estimated 8 cfs - clean

Importance - spawning and nursery area for steelhead and silver salmon.

<u>Miles of stream available</u> - approximately one and one-half miles of spawning stream - 30% can be successfully utilized. Approximately one-half mile is available for nursery stream.

<u>Summer conditions</u> - one-half mile of permanent stream available to fishlife, as reported by local residence.

<u>Fish present</u> - one RT-SH $(4\frac{1}{2})$ and 10 roach seined one-half mile above mouth, and one RT-SH (5) one and one-half miles above mouth. Many pools and riffles seined.

<u>Shelter</u> - Fair to poor.

Recommendations -

- 1. Complete a stream survey at time when conditions are best for finding fish present.
- 2. Evaluate summer condition of stream and locate nursery areas.
- 3. Determine type of improvement necessary to increase fish production.
