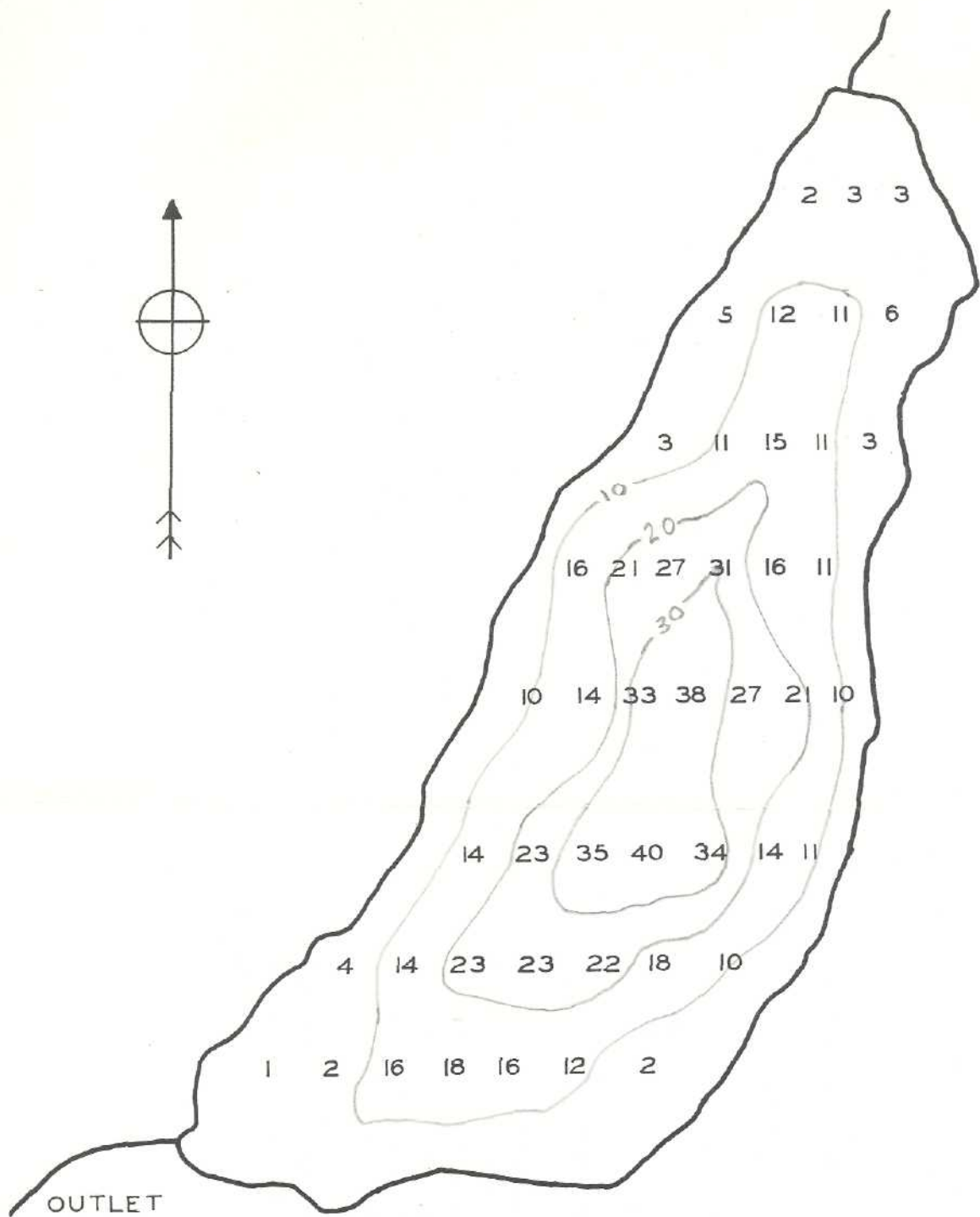

Suggested Management

The introduction of smallmouth bass into Bowler Pond by unauthorized plantings within the past ten years has probably been responsible for their introduction into Sheepscot Pond via the outlet of Bowler Pond to the detriment of the cold water fishes in Sheepscot Pond.

Some "trout water" occurs in Bowler Pond creating the possibility of managing the pond for trout. It is recommended that Bowler Pond be reclaimed and then managed for brook trout.
