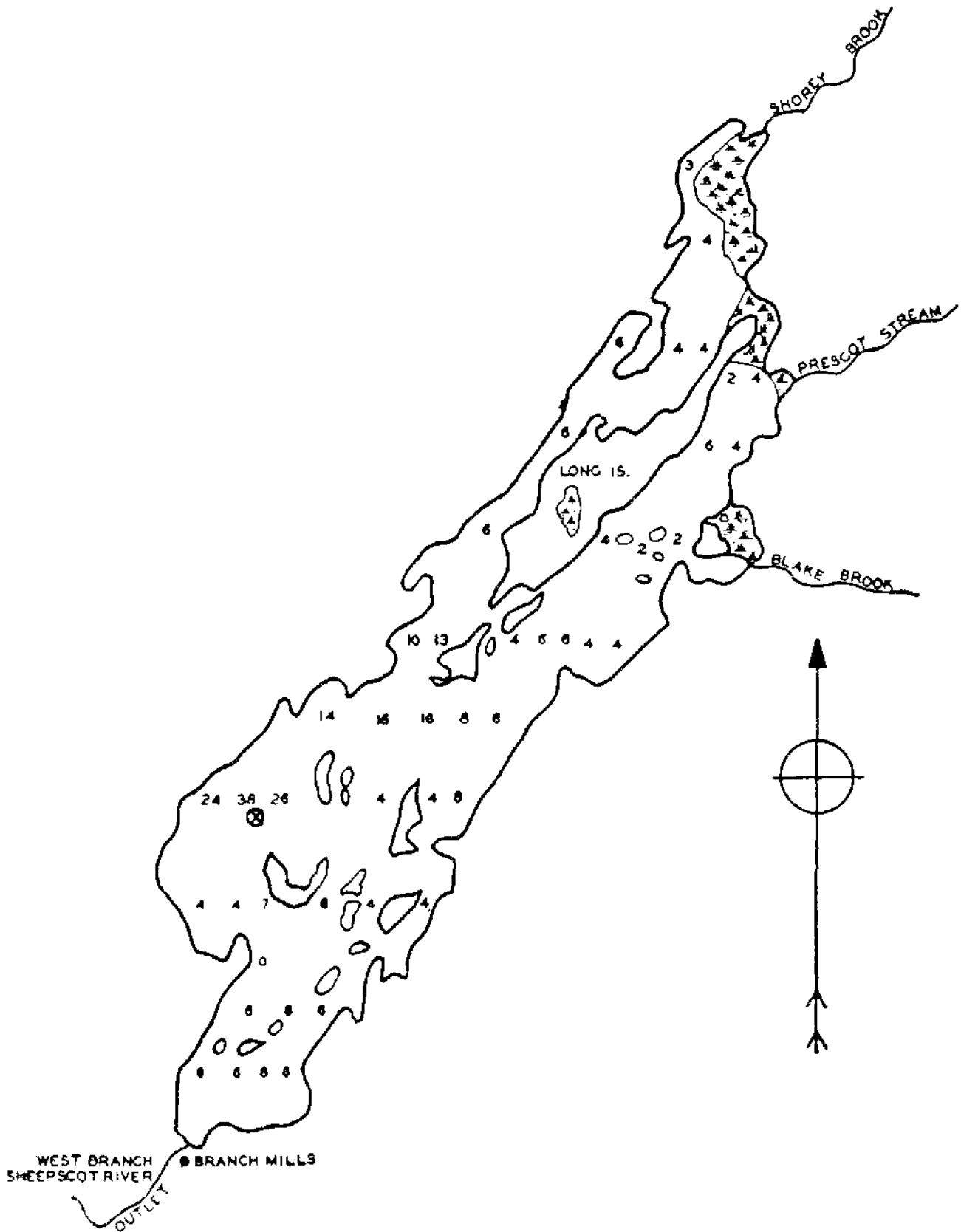

Suggested Management

Branch Pond should be managed as a white perch and pickerel pond. The small amount of cold water present is deficient in oxygen; therefore, trout or salmon could not be expected to provide satisfactory fishing.

No stocking of any kind is recommended. Particular care should be exercised that bass are not introduced. The Sheepscot River drainage should be kept free of this species to protect the salmon fishery in Sheepscot Pond.
